Continuum Center sets aging program

The Continuum Center at Oakland University, Rochester, is offering workshops to help those who work with older adults expand their awareness and update their skills.

"The basis of the workshop training is to increase empathy for older people by helping service providers understand their special needs," says Betty White, coordinator of the Older Adult Project at the Continuum Center. She will conduct the training with Lucille Epstein, another staff member.

The workshop schedule:

- March 7—"An overview of Aging." The myths and realities of aging, the physical changes, and the loss of support systems will be explored.
- March 14—"Communication and Counseling." The emphasis will be on assertiveness techniques, listening techniques and open-ended questions.
- March 21—"Organization and Dynamics of Groups." The program will center on the types of goals, norms and leadership of groups.

•March 28—"Volunteers." This session will focus on the selection, motivation and utilization of volunteers.

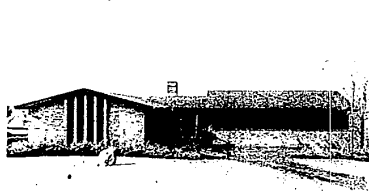
