For as long as the earth has had an atmosphere, there has been air pollution. But for millions of years nature was able to take care of itself. However, with the coming of the industrial age, man's ability to pollute overpowered nature's ability to purify. A high Pollution Standard Index (PSI) on any given day followed by a low

reading the next day only means the pollution has moved, not disappeared. All pollutants which go into the air will eventually return to earth, brought down by rain, snow and gravity. In spite of federal legislation to control air pollution many Americans still breathe air that is dirtier than the law allows.

Dirty air makes eyes water, burns throats and causes lung disease. It rusts metal, erodes stone, rots fiber, discolors paints, and soils clothing. It severely damages trees and food crops and stunts the growth of shrubs and flowers. Air pollution reduces visibility. It can ground planes and bring road traffic to a crawl.

In terms of damage to health, property, materials and vegetation, air pollution costs the people of the United States an estimated \$20 billion every year.

All of us pay the price of air pollution in one way or another. Restoring quality to the air we breathe is indeed something to worry about and is one of the most important and challenging problems facing this country.




