Atkinson, often referred to as a Renaissance man, is remembered in Michigan for his long association as design director for Glen of

Michigan, which won him acclaim for his concepts of women's sportclothes. In 1958, he was named fashion designer of the year, In 1973, he opened Bill Atkinson, Ltd., and has since designed the uniforms for Amtrak's and the Hilton hotels' staffs.
