

Allison, neighbors together

"The Bob Allison Show" starring Bob Allison, a Birmingham resident, has moved to WJLD Radio (1090 AM). Metropolitan Detroiters have been asking their neighbors for helpful hints over the radio for close to two decades on Allison's show.

For 16 years Allison was on WWJ Radio every morning until the station's decision to go to an all-news format.

"The Bob Allison Show" is heard Monday-Friday, 10-11 a.m. Questions may be telephoned in to 325-3250; answers to 345-7770.

ALLISON'S SHOW consists of questions and answers, and now the answers are taken immediately following the question.

Allison said, "By installing two different phones—one for questions and one for answers only—we are able to control the flow of information. Because the show is only one hour long, we pick up the tempo and make the calls briefer than before."

"To accomplish this, callers are allowed to ask or answer just one question per call. We also have eliminated the actual taking of recipes on the air which used to involve an immense amount of time."

He explained that when questions about a recipe are asked, the caller is directed to another source: A cookbook, newspaper or magazine.

"The savings in time makes the show much more enjoyable to hear and, of course, gets more people on the air."


