Monday, June 19: First two-week session of Riding Day Camp, at Rochester Hills Riding School, starts this

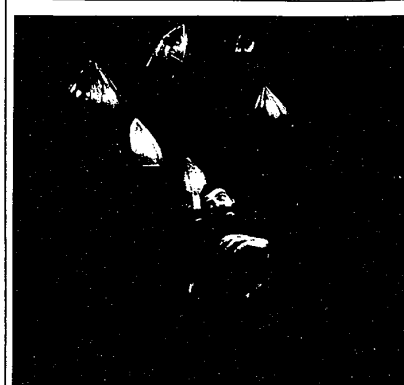
