In 1882, the year the first Labor Day was celebrated, it was a day to honor all workers.

Peter J. McGuire, a president of the United Brotherhood of Carpenters and Joiners of America, made the proposal to the New York Central Labor Union that Labor Day be noted on the first Monday in September.

He thought there should be a special honor given to the industrial spirit.

"the great vital force of the nation," since there were already days representing the religious, civil and military spirit, according to Maymie R. Keybe, the author of "All About American Holidays."

The first Labor Day was on Sept. 5, 1882 in New York City. About 10,000 workers paraded around the city, although they had been warned not to leave their jobs. The celebration was accompanied with music from a band and with mounted police.

By 1928, all 48 states and dependencies except Wyoming and the Philippines, had declared Labor Day a legal holiday. The day commemorating the contributions labor makes to life in the U.S. is now celebrated in all the states.
