ORCHARD LAKE ROAD LOCATION AND DESIGN STUDY SUBMITTED TO THE FEDERAL HIGHWAY ADMINISTRATION FOR APPROVAL

The Oakland County Road Commission has successfully completed the environmental study for the widening of Orchard Lake Road between Twelve Mile Road and Will-O-Way Street. Approval by the Federal Highway Administration was given on August 28, 1978, following a public hearing on the Negative Declaration. The Road Commission is proceeding to the next step toward qualifying its project for Federal funding.

Notice is hereby given, as required by Federal Aid Highway Program Manual 7-7.5, that the Road Commission has prepared the Location and Design Study Report and is seeking State and Federal approval of it. After receiving such approvals, it will be possible for the Oakland County Road Commission to design, acquire right-of-way, and construct the project.

The Location and Design Study Report, the Final Negative Declaration, and all backup materials are available for public inspection and copying at the Oakland County Road Commission offices, 3101 Lathrop Road, Beverly Hills. They are available between the hours of 8 a.m. and 4:45 p.m.
