
'Good Morning, Detroit' visits mall

Channel 2 came to Somerset Mall Tuesday morning to tape the "Good Morning, Detroit" show, as promised, but host Vic Caprio who had been scheduled couldn't make it. He was in Rome covering the story of the new pope. Channel 2's Ray Lane, who has been filling in as host on "Good Morning, Detroit" came instead, to interview David Smokey Gaines, basketball coach from the University of Detroit, and Detroit Free Press columnist Bob Talbert. Reporter Nancy Macauley was

there, too, and she and Lane both talked with Ken Dewey, fashion director of Saks Fifth Avenue while men and women models showed new fall looks. The public was invited to attend the taping, and a group of about 75 persons gathered, sitting on folding chairs that had been set up, and standing. TAPING A SHOW goes slowly, with the action stopping after each segment. Host Lane would step out to the audience to explain what was happening, however, and the stage man-

ager cued the audience on when to applaud. The taping was supposed to begin at 11 a.m., but workmen were pounding with hammers and buzzing with saws behind wooden barricades while new shops were going in (at the old Abercrombie & Fitch location). "Good Morning, Detroit" began taping at 11:30 a.m. and was still taping a second fashion segment at 1 p.m. Behno's outdoor French cafe was in the background for the show. Host Lane and his guest were seated on a dais, at a wrought-iron table and

chairs just like the ones at Behno's. This was the third Detroit-area shopping center where the show was taped recently. The tapings were tied in with a photographic exhibit marking the station's 30th year. You won't be able to catch the show from Somerset on your television set, however. It was shown the morning after, on Wednesday. "Good Morning, Detroit" is on WJBK-TV from 7-8 a.m. weekdays. The Photo exhibit, a nostalgic view of news stories from the last 30 years, continues through Saturday.
