Nizer opens fair

Louis Nizer, attorney and author, will be the opening night speaker at the 27th annual Jewish Book Fair at 8 p.m. Saturday in the Jewish Community Center of Metropolitan Detroit, 6600 W. Maple, West Bloomfield.

The fair, which will continue through Nov. 14, will include speakers David Rosenberg, Belva Plain, Alon Ben-Meir, Ruth Gruber, Joseph Borkin, Esther Broner, Gershon Shaked, Ruth Kaminska and Stanley Feldstein.

"Reflections Without Mirrors" is the latest book by Nizer, who practices law in New York and Washington, D.C., in which he reflects on his work as a trial lawyer.

Speaking on Sunday will be Ruth Kaminska, Prof. Shaked and Feldstein. Author of "I Don't Want to be Brave Any More," Ms. Kaminska will begin her talk at 1:45 p.m. Her topic is Soviet injustice, yesterday and today. During her 16 years in the Soviet Union, she was a privileged actress and singer and later a prisoner in a Russian concentration camp.

The lecture by Prof. Shaked, professor of literature at Hebrew University in Jerusalem, will start at 3:30 p.m. He is author of "The History of Modern Hebrew Literature." His topic is the literature of the Diaspora and Israel.

Author of "The Land That I Show You," Feldstein will speak at 8 p.m.

His talk will be on early Jewish settlers of the U.S.

David Rosenberg, Belva Plain and Alon Ben-Meir are Monday lecturers. At 10 a.m. Rosenberg, writer of "Lightworks," "Blues of the Sky" and "Job Speaks" will discuss "Who's Afraid of the Bible (and its Jewish Poetry)?"

The 1 p.m. talk, "The Myth of the Jewish Mother," will be given by Ms. Plain, author of "Evergreen," a novel about a young woman coming to New York at the turn of the century from a Polish shtetl.

The Middle East after the Sadat visit and Camp David Summit will be addressed by Ben-Meir, Israeli author and lecturer, at 8 p.m. He has written about socio-economic and political problems in Israel.

As one of the Tuesday speakers, Ms. Gruber will talk at 10 a.m. on what it means to be a woman of Israel. Her latest book is "Racquel: A Woman of Israel."

The author of "The Crime and Punishment of I.G. Farben," Joseph Borkin, will talk at 1 p.m. about his work as chief of the patent and cartel section of the antitrust division of the U.S. Department of Justice when he was responsible for the investigation and prosecution of the I.G. Farben dominated cartels.

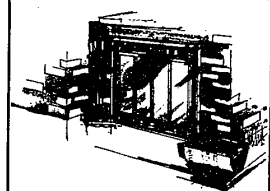
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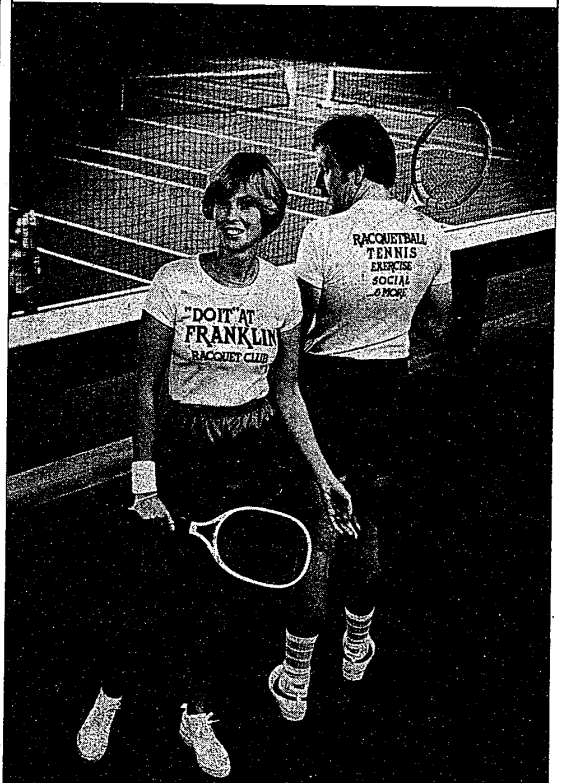


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
