

Tennis Classic deadline nears

The entry deadline is drawing near for the first-ever Holiday Tennis Classic, Dec. 26-30, at the Franklin Racquet Club.

The final registration date is Dec. 18. Co-sponsored by the Eccentric Newspapers, the tournament will benefit the American Cancer Society. Members of the group will help officiate the tournament.

Twenty different titles will be at stake for the tournament, known to be the only tournament of its kind held during the holiday period in southeastern Michigan.

Four divisions have been set for the tournament allowing the players to compete at various skill levels. The rating system gives netters a chance to play against competition which is compatible. The system has been used in leagues at the Franklin Racquet Club and other tennis houses in the area.

The tournament is open to players with the Eccentric Newspapers' range.

According to Bev Waggoner, tournament director, entries for the Holiday Classic are on the rise. Waggoner said many junior players have already signed up for the event.

The tourney director also said that many of the Suburban Tennis League club travel players are starting to enter.

The Suburban Tennis League regulars may have an advantage in this tournament because they are familiar with the court surface at the Franklin Racquet Club.

The finals for the tourney are scheduled for 9:30 a.m. to 2 p.m. Saturday, Dec. 30.

JUNIORS - 9:00-12:00 noon. WOMEN - 1:00-4:00 p.m. MEN - 5:00-11:00 p.m. All matches will be played Tuesday and Wednesdays. Doubles will be played on Thursday and Friday. This applies to both men and women events. 6. Trophies will be awarded to winners and runners-up in each division. 7. Default time of 15 minutes will be enforced. 8. All matches are 2 out of 3 sets with a 9 point tie-breaker at 6 all, 9, 10 minute warm-up. 10. All matches will be played at Franklin, 11. Entry deadline is December 18, 1979. 12.
