Daniel quits as S-L cage coach

Southfield-Lathrup's Chuck Daniel would have ended his seven-year coaching career with at least 100 victories had his girls' basketball team beaten Brighton last Saturday in the Class A regional final at Lathrup.

But Brighton eliminated Lathrup, 51-35, and Daniel bowed out with a 99-34 career record.
"It's about time for me to move on," said Daniel after the game. "Even a preacher shouldn't stay at a congregation for too long. Eventually, everybody's heard all his sermons."
Daniel, one of Michigan's most successful high school girls' basketball coaches, guided Lathrup to four Metro Suburban Association championships, four state district titles and two-regional crowns.

In 1976, Lathrup advanced to the Class A semifinals before losing to state runner up Farmington Our Lady of Mercy.

Despite a mediocre regular season, the 1978 Chargers came on strong in the state tournament, whipping a tough Pontiac Central team in the district final, and then topping Walled Lake Central in the regional opener on Dec. 6.
Brighton's victory last Saturday ended Lathrup's season at 19-9 overall. The Chargers tied Bloomfield Hills Lahser for second place in the MSA. Rochester Adams won the league title.

DANIEL SAID he had made his decision to resign as coach before this season started.
"I just think it's time for a new

coach," he said. "Plus there are other things I'd like to do at school, and basketball takes a lot of my time."

"I'm working now with the Pep Club, trying to get up some school spirit. I'd like to see the day when we have two busloads of students at every away football and basketball game. And we'd like to get them interested in the other sports, too."

No successor has been named, but Daniel said it would be "a good idea" if the school appointed a woman coach.

"A male coach just loses too much in communicating with the girls," he said. "The coach should be in the locker room with the girls. Of course, I can be in the locker room with my players, but somehow it's not the same thing as it would be with a woman coach."

Daniel, a manual arts teacher at Lathrup, added: "I've had a wonderful seven or eight years as coach here, and it's done a lot for me. I've had some very good athletes."

Davison wins mat tourney

Davison won four dual meets and finished first in the Southfield-Lathrup Dual Invitational wrestling tournament last Saturday. Mount Clemens, with a 3-1 record, finished second. Lathrup (2-2) took third place followed by North Farmington (1-3) and Madison Heights Lamphere (0-4).

Lamphere's Steve Zuzadiak was named the tournament's most valuable wrestler for his showing in the 96-pound class. He won all four matches on five perfect pins.
Lathrup's Rob Parent, now 10-0 in dual meets, won the 126-pound class, pinning runner-up Karry Jones of Davison in 1:26.
