ZIPs urged for holidays

Southfield Postal Service officials this week urged customers to use ZIP codes on the addresses and return addresses of all holiday mail. Customers also were urged to make sure the correct postage is attached to each envelope.

By following these suggestions, customers will be assured good mail service this season," said William E. Fleming, officer-in-charge at the Southfield Post Office on Eleven Mile. Envelopes without postage will be returned to senders, if possible, or delayed by postage-due procedures, he said. When the return address is placed on holiday mail, it also helps to remind friends of the sender's current address, Fleming added.

If the family to whom a holiday message is sent has moved more than a year ago, it cannot be forwarded. With a return address, Fleming said, such letters are returned to the sender with a notation that the forwarding request has expired.

Christmas buying tips

1. Know size ranges and buy the right size.
2. Read and keep labels and tags.
3. Keep sales slips for possible exchanges.
