ZIPs urged for holidays

Southfield Postal Service officials this week urged customers to use ZIP codes on the addresses and return addresses of all holiday mail. Customers also were urged to make sure the correct postage is attached to each en

erwelope.
"By following these suggestions, customers will be assured good mail service this season." said William E. Fleming, officer-in-charge at the Southfield Post Office on Eleven Mile.
Envelopes without postage will be

returned to senders, if possible, or-delayed by postage-due procedures, he said. When the return address is placed on boliday mail, a last possible to-renind friends of the sender's current. Address, Flening added. If the family to whom a holiday mes-sage is sent has moved more than a year ago, it cannot be forwarded. With a return address, Flening said, such letters are returned to the sender with. a notation that the forwarding request, has expired.
