

Local auditions herald season

Local auditions for the second season of productions at the Birmingham Theatre will be held Wednesday-Saturday, Jan. 17-20.

Unlike the first season, when road shows were presented, the theater will produce all its own plays in the new season.

Auditions for members of Actors Equity Association are slated for Jan. 17-18 and for other interested actors on Jan. 19-20. The theater is located at 211 S. Woodward.

Each play will feature a star from stage, television or motion pictures, and local talent will be used in supporting roles. The shows will be contemporary in theme, offering a broad sampling of entertainment from comedy to suspense.

The theater has cut ticket prices by more than half, with season subscription tickets ranging from \$4.13 to \$9 per play.

The following roles will be available to local actors:

For "Hold Me" by Jules Feiffer:
One man, '30s, funny and must play various characters.

Two women, '30s, funny and must play various characters.

One woman, early '20s, sweet, innocent to play a dancer.

For "Veronica's Room" by Ira Levin:
One man, early '30s, handsome, diabolical.

One man, mid-'50s, servile, mild-mannered.

One woman, mid-'50s, domineering, insane.

For "Hooters" by Ted Tally:
One young man, early '20s, punk, spoiled, aggressive.

One young man, early '20s, handsome, boyish looks, innocent.

One young woman, early '20s, snobbish, refined.

One young woman, mid-'20s, beautiful, confident.

For "Ladyhouse Blues" by Kevin O'Morrison:
One girl, late teens, naive, curious.

One young woman, mid-'20s, pregnant, wealthy but uncultured.

One woman, late '20s, independent, political.

One woman, early '30s, depressed, sickly.

Each audition will be five minutes in duration and will include a two-minute prepared audition, a reading from the script, movement and improvisation.

Music school offers jazz, dance courses

Students registering for courses offered by the Center for Creative Studies-College of Art and Design Extension Program may want to sign up for "History of Jazz" or "Beginning Modern Dance."

These classes are part of the Detroit Community Music School's curriculum and are offered as credit courses through the Center for Creative Studies or non credit courses through the music school.

"History of Jazz" is a historical survey of the roots of jazz in America, including ragtime, the swing era, blues and bands of the 1950s. Recording media and live performers will be utilized in the class which meets 7-8:30 p.m.,

Mondays and Wednesdays, Jan. 29-June 12. Class fee is \$270 for this three credit course.

"Beginning Modern Dance" is offered 7:30-9 p.m., Tuesdays and Thursdays, Jan. 26-June 12. The course is a studio introduction to form through physical alignment and movement vocabulary, and limited composition. A fee of \$135 is charged for this 1.5-credit course.

Registration deadline is Friday for both classes.

Jazz show directors gathering at workshop

A special one-day workshop for musical directors of school jazz and show choirs will be held on the campus of Oakland University Saturday, Jan. 27, in Varner Hall.

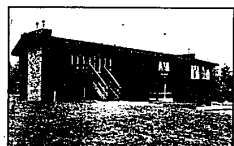

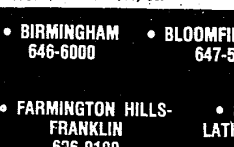
