The chorus has members from several counties and will arrange rides by calling 728-2130 or 791-6106.

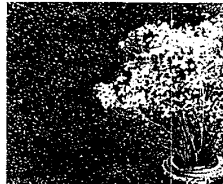
Members plan a demonstration of barbershop harmony, instruction in vocal technique, the chapter history in photos and mementoes and other informative and entertaining activities.
