Seniors apply for discounts

As the Oakland Livingston Human Service Agency's senior discount program nears its second anniversary, the search continues for seniors and merchants to participate in the project.

On Feb. 9, the Oakland Senior Discount Program will be at Mercy Center, 28800 Eleven Mile, Farmington Hills, to sign applicants. Pictures for senior ID cards will be taken.

The cards allow seniors to take advantage of discounts ranging from five to 40 per cent on food, clothing, hearing aids, books, household goods and other common items.

The project's emphasis on more common items is in keeping with its goal of helping seniors on fixed incomes stretch their money as far as possible, according to Marty Kinella, public information coordinator for the agency.

Since Feb. 14, 1977, the program has enlisted 39,813 of 100,000 Oakland County residents over 60.

"There is a need for the discount program," said Loretta Conway, director of the Gathering Place. "It's good for the members and it's good for the merchants. It draws more people into their stores with the seniors and their families."

MERCHANTS WHO SIGN up for the program choose the amount of discount their store will offer and the types of merchandise or services which will be covered, according to Helen Castora of the Human Service Agency.

While Livingston County has a similar program, the discount cards from Oakland County don't transfer to the second project, according to Ms. Conway.

In Farmington, seniors can use their

discount cards the following businesses: • Farmington Wishing Well on Farmington Road offers 10 per cent discounts for seniors under the program. Its breakfast special isn't included in the offer.

• Farmington Lumber on Grand River offers 10 per cent discount to seniors on lumber, building materials, and hardware. Sales are exempt.

• Open Book on Middlebelt offers 10 per cent discount on all books. Magazines and newspapers aren't included.

• Graf's Pastery, Twelve Mile near Orchard Lake Road, offers 10 per cent discount on French pastries and tortes.

• Happiness Is Gift Shop, Eleven Mile near Middlebelt, offers 10 per cent on cards, gifts and flowers. This excludes special orders, sales and delivery.

• Innovations Salon, Twelve Mile across from Harrison High School, offers 10 per cent discount on any service.

• Irving's on Middlebelt offers 10 per cent discount on all merchandise except sale items.

• Jeans' Hardware, Twelve Mile across from Harrison High School, offers 10 per cent discounts except on sale items.

• Bob Prima Music, Middle Middlebelt, offers 10 per cent discounts to seniors in the program on all merchandise except sale items. There are special rates on organs and pianos.

• Fisher Shell offers 10 per cent on car repairs, maintenance.

• Duquette Jewelers on Grand River offers 15 per cent discount on all jewelry items which are made for sale. Special orders are exempt from the offer.

• Jerome Shops on Grand River offer 10 per cent discount on shoes, bags. Sale items are exempt.

SENIORS CAN USE their discount cards in participating stores throughout Oakland County. Seniors who wish to join the program must live in Oakland County. There is no charge for the identification card.

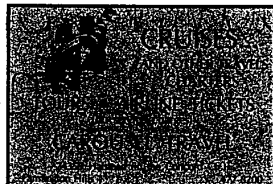
