Guest plays Oscar Madison and Martin is Felix Unger—the two mismatched roommates—in the Nancy Gurwin production. The show at 8:30 p.m. follows a 7 p.m. dinner Wednesdays. On Sundays, the play at 7:30 p.m. follows a 6 p.m. dinner.

Guest III, a graduate of Denison University, is not only an actor but a director, producer and lecturer. LATER, HE toured Michigan, Ohio, Indiana and New York with his one-man show "American Humor." Guest has acted in and directed numerous productions for St. Dunstan's Guild of Cranbrook, including "Damn Yankees," "The Fantasticks," "How to Succeed in Business" and "South Pacific."

He also has directed for the Detroit Parks and Recreation Department and for Project Hope and has served as public relations director for Meadow Brook Theatre for two years.

For the last several years, Guest has been associated with many dinner theater productions in the Detroit area. He directed "Last of the Red Hot Lovers," "Star Spangled Girl" and "A Thruher Carnival."

He won critical acclaim for his portrayal of Barney Cashman in "Last of the Red Hot Lovers," a Nancy Gurwin production, and also directed for this company the musical productions "I Do! I Do!" and "Once Upon a Mattress" as well as the comedy hit "The Odd Couple."

Kent Martin brings a wealth of dramatic expertise to dinner playhouse. He has a background of producer-directorship for theatrical companies, as well as Hollywood film and TV commercial acting experience.
