Sandi Mohacs, 18-year-old daughter of Mary Mohacs, four time Detroit Bowling Queen, brought further honor to the Detroit area over the past weekend when she finished third in the National Youth Championships in Washington, D.C.

By placing so high of the standings board she won a \$1,000 scholarship and also had the distinction of rolling the high game of the entire tournament with a 254. She also had the thrill of being on national television.

This was the 25th anniversary of the tournament and Michigan figured prominently in the opener when Kit Konkle, of Grand Rapids won the singles title.

THE GOOD OLD DAYS proved high-

ly successful in the area's establishments over the past weekend and in many cases established new records for open bowling.

The program calling for 25 cents a line charge for bowling and 25 cents for a hot dog over the two-day period and Westland Bowl topped the area with the sale of 3,400 hot dogs. At times the 60 lanes were filled with the open bowlers.

Merri-Bowl reported the sale of 2,000 hot dogs — a new high for the house — while Garden Lanes also hit the 2,000 mark and Woodland Lanes also dispensed several thousand. At Super Bowl the amount was in the thousands, but no official count was kept.

Even Plymouth Bowl, where it had

been quiet most of the summer, had 1,400 hot dog and bowling customers.

While it will be a week before the final returns are in, the proprietors claim the promotion was one of the best they ever sponsored.

HAROLD VON BERGEN, who has reached the ripe old age of 77, reached the high point of the Senior Citizens League at Merri-Bowl in his last outing.

He put together games of 233, 235 and 200 for a 668 and easily out-distanced all of his rivals.

AIDED BY AN opening game of 255, Rick Lang went on to roll a 683 series and take top honors in the Trio League at Westland Bowl. Following his big opener, Rick added a 225 and a 201 to win a dogged battle with Frank Muggler, who posted a 680. Muggler had games of 214, 221 and 245. Third place went to Frank Briscoe, who had a 255 in 663.
