

Wildcats maul tournament foes

Thursday, August 23, 1979

The South Farmington Wildcats batted to their second softball tournament title in a week, capturing the Third Annual Shag Invitational with five straight victories last weekend in Walled Lake.

The Wildcats, who won the Inter Lakes Traveling League tournament the previous weekend, combined timely hitting with solid pitching to win at Walled Lake.

Betsy VanDeusen pitched all five games for the Wildcats, surrendering just 11 runs. Her performance earned her the Most Valuable Player the trophy.

The team's biggest test came in a 3-2 win in the semifinal game against Redford Sunday. Redford scored twice in the first inning and held that lead until the bottom of the fourth.

South Farmington cut Redford's lead to 2-1 in that inning on a single by Linda Bache, an error by the Redford left-fielder on Kay Deeg's fly ball, and a single by VanDeusen.

The Wildcats scored two more in the fifth to take the lead. Jean Zuborski doubled to lead off the inning one out-er and Marsha Perry singled. Cindy Pink knocked in Zuborski with the tying run on a force out at second base.

Nancy McGovern then singled, moving Pink to third, and Denise Goyette doubled to score Pink with the gamewinner.

In the championship game against Northville Sunday, the defense came up with some big plays and Wendy Di-erkes and Pink had the clutch hits to key a 3-1 South Farmington win.

DIERKES, WHO HAD two hits and scored two runs in the contest, got things started in the second with a lead-off single. After two fly outs, Per-

ry was safe on the Northville third baseman's error, and Pink followed with a clutch triple to score both runners.

Diernes again started things in the fourth inning with a single. The next two Wildcats were retired, but then Perry walked and Pink singled, loading the bases. McGovern walked, forcing in the team's final run.

But the defense deserved much of the credit for the win. Goyette made a great running catch in the seventh inning in right center field which saved at least one run, and double plays in the first and sixth innings got VanDeusen out of jams.

The Wildcats played three games on Saturday, but only the first was a challenge. The South Farmington squad defeated Romeo, 7-6, in their opening game of the tournament.

The eventual winning run was scored in the fourth inning on a sacrifice fly by Sue Carruthers that scored Janice Dorsch. The run gave the Wildcats a 7-1 lead, but Romeo rallied for three runs in the fifth and two more in the sixth to tie the game.

Bache and Zuborski led the offense for South Farmington, Bache collecting two hits in two trips and Zuborski slammng a triple in the first that scored two runs.

The second and third contests were no problem for the Wildcats, as they beat Garden City Jakes, 10-1, and downed Howell, 6-1.

Diernes, Zuborski and McGovern each had two hits and two runs batted in against Garden City. Bache also had two hits, and Marilyn Goyette contributed a triple and drove in two runs.

Against Howell, VanDeusen had three hits in three trips. Deeg had two hits and an RBI, and Dorsch collected

two safes. Diernes was the team's leading hitter during the tournament with a .429 average. She also had four runs batted in. Zuborski was the team leader in RBIs with 5 and batted .357 for the tournament.
