

# Kresge Foundation makes \$100,000 grant to college

Madonna College of Livonia will get \$100,000 from the Kresge Foundation to complete its current building program...

Sister Mary Franciene, Madonna president, called the task "an achievable goal."

She pointed out that Madonna's development staff already had moved along the way to financing the project to the tune of \$97,250.

The Kresge Foundation, based in Troy, made what it terms a Challenge Grant to the college that is renovating and expanding its academic and activities facilities.

The building addition, begun in September of last year, recently was completed and will be fully utilized in the fall term, which begins Sept. 4. It provides three additional classrooms, 13 offices for faculty members, an elevator for faculty members, an elevator center and shower and locker room facilities for Madonna's male students.

Special facilities for the college deaf and hearing-impaired students also are housed there.

THE CHALLENGE Grant is the third from the Kresge Foundation to Madonna in the past four years. An announcement from the foundation said the Livonia college was one of 177 granted a share of \$85.1 million, and the recipients were selected from among 1,199 qualified proposals.

In order to qualify for the money, new plans for proposals and visitations are being planned under the direction of Sister Mary Lauriana, vice president for development.

In addition, there have been grants from five private foundations totaling \$38,100. The most recent is a \$5,000 grant from the Raskob Foundation of
