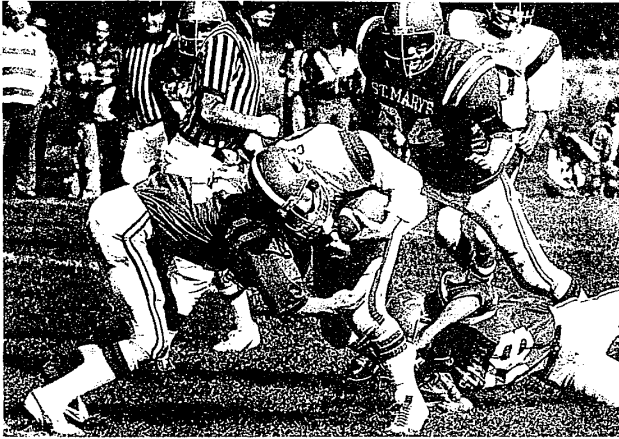


# OLSM conquers St. Andrew

pass from Kinville to Brett Green provided OLSM with its third touchdown and an 18-0 halftime lead.

The Eagles scored on their first possession of the third period, with Beckett covering the final 29 yards for the score. This time, freshman kicker Tim Gaffigan booted the extra point and put OLSM in front, 20-0.

GREEN SCORED his second touchdown of the game late in the period after Mike Landry blocked a St. Andrew punt. OLSM got the ball at the St. Andrew 29, and on the first play Green busted it for the TD. Gaffigan's kick was good, making the score 32-0.

Cowart scored for St. Andrew late in the third quarter, and Green added his third touchdown in the fourth on a 14-yard run to complete the scoring.

OLSM's offense ground out 419 yards against St. Andrew, 290 of it coming on the ground. Selakowski was the leading rusher with 107 yards on 14 attempts. Green gained 60 yards on seven carries, and Biebuyck had 40 yards on seven tries.

Everything fell into place for Orchard Lake St. Mary last Sunday, as it blitzed Catholic C-D League opponent Detroit St. Andrew, 39-6.

The offense, which had been almost nonexistent in back-to-back losses to Detroit Country Day and Detroit Benedictine, scored the first time it had the ball and almost every time after that.

The defense kept St. Andrew bottled up in its own end for most of the afternoon and provided good field position for the offense. The Eagles so overpowered St. Andrew that OLSM didn't punt once during the contest.

"I was pleased, very pleased, with the way the kids played after two disappointing losses," OLSM coach Al Dicken said. "Our offense jelled and played the way it's capable of playing. "And we didn't make the mistakes we had made before."

The only mistakes OLSM made were failing to convert extra point plays in the first half, fumbling once, and breaking down for one play on defense and allowing a 43-yard touchdown run by St. Andrew's Dave Cowart in the third quarter.

But by that time OLSM had the game well in hand. Quarterback Jim Kinville rebounded from a poor game against Benedictine to an almost flawless performance. Kinville ran for one touchdown and passed for another. He threw nine times and completed six for 129 yards.

BUT THE REST of the offense was strong, too. A short SL Andrew punt and a 10-yard return by Mark Goddard set up the first Eagle score. Bob Selakowski most of the work in the drive, which began at the St. Andrew 59-yard line.

Selakowski carried three times for 26 yards, his last run setting up Kinville's three-yard touchdown run. The extra point kick failed, but OLSM was on the board with a 6-0 lead.

The Eagles added two more scores in the second quarter. The first came after another short St. Andrew punt, giving OLSM the ball on the St. Andrew 43.

Burt Biebuyck's 12-yard run started the drive and, nine plays later, Selakowski scored from three yards out to give OLSM a 12-0 lead.

Late in the half OLSM started another drive, this time going 77 yards in eight plays. Ryan Beckett carried for 14 yards, Selakowski had runs of nine and 12 yards, and a Kinville-to-Garland pass gained 23 yards. An eight-yard
