

New Michigan residents who have not met the six-month residency requirements are still eligible to vote Nov. 5 for president and vice presi-

for president and vice president.

They will be restricted from voting for local candidates, however.

Michigan law says that you must live here six months to be classified an official resident prior to any election. This means that you would have to have been living here on or before April 4, 1988 to vote in November.

NON-RESIDENTS of Michigan, he explained, must apply to the state they moved from and get an affidavit proving they would have been eligible to vote there.

They then bring this affidavit to the election headquarters in their new home town. They will not be registered, he said, but they will use on election day at that particular office.

The township or city clerk is the chief election officer in any town and is the person to contact.

ONCE THE PERSON affirms he was eligible to vote in his former state, he will be allowed to vote at the election headquarters in his new town.
