Capitol Roundup: Draft, 'Breakthrough,' Pollution

WASHINGTON U.S. Congressmen representing Observers' three districts issued three different issues in recent press releases.

NDC Gets 5,000 More Signatures

Livonia, Farmington and Redford's 19th Congressional District New Democratic Coalition (NDC) members descended on Detroit election centers Nov. 4 and collected 5,000 signatures on presidential primary election petitions.

This group thus boosted the day's signature total to 25,000 about one-quarter of the 100,000 thus far collected by state-wide supporters.

To force an initiative ballot in Michigan a total of 195,000 signatures are needed.

The 19th District NDC idea to solicit at the polls election day was proposed by Marilyn Scott of Livonia at a recent NDC state convention.

"It turned out to be a tremendous success," said Jeanne Havast, Livonia NDC publicist.

Canvassing shopping centers, grocery stores and the Farmington Founders' Festival earlier, this local group secured Republican Michigan Governor William Milliken's signature. Basic changes advocated by the petitioners include nomination of presidential candidates by popular vote, rather than by partisan party conventions.

Also advocated is a modified version of the electoral college system for final election of the president.

Give Thanks, Give Blood

Planter Pad

A planter platform makes a handsome, useful patio accessory. Along one edge of the patio, build a big cedar box five feet wide by seven or more feet long. "The institution of a random system of selection among eligible men throughout the nation will assure that all men, wherever they live, will face an equal chance to be drafted."

"At the same time, establishment of a 19-year-old first policy will assure that men are eligible for the draft only one year and, following that year, will be able to make concrete plans for their futures."

"College students and others who are deferred will be considered to be 19 for one year following expiration of their deferments," said Esch.

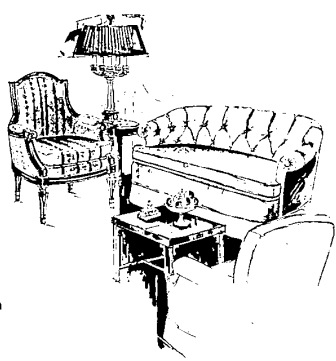

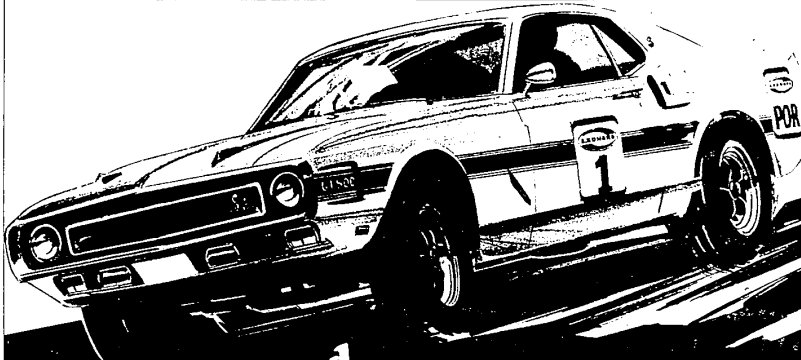
