

Kitchens Furnish Yule Gifts

For all those special people whom you want to remember at Christmas with very special gifts, a day in your kitchen and a visit to the dime store may solve all your problems.

An apothecary jar filled with your own Roquefort dressing, teamed with a bottle of celery vinegar will please any salad-loving friend. Put both in a plastic bowl-suitable for salad washing or even serving - tie them up in a checkered dish towel, and add a sprig of holly and they're ready for Christmas giving.

Your list should include red, green and gold foil for wrapping cookies, individual fruit cakes and jars of Christmas marmalade or mincemeat. Add some clear plastic boxes, some small candy canes and a supply of ribbon and you're in business.

Now to the kitchen--

INDIVIDUAL FRUIT CAKES

1 lb. walnuts
1 lb. pitted dates
3/4 lb. candied cherries
1 lb. candied pineapple, diced
2 c. all-purpose flour
2 c. sugar
1/2 t. baking powder
1/2 t. salt
3 eggs, well beaten
1/2 t. almond extract
Combine the nuts and fruit in a large bowl. Only the pineapple is diced; the nuts and other fruits are left whole. Sift the flour with the salt, baking powder and sugar. Mix thoroughly, using hands, so that all the fruit and nuts are well coated with the flour. Mix the beaten eggs with the almond extract and fold into the fruits. Blend well. Pack in foil baking cups, filling them well. Bake in a 300-degree oven about 40 minutes. Yields about 30 small cups. Note: These can be made well in advance. They keep well in a cool place or they can be frozen for two to three months. Wrapped in foil and tied to the Christmas tree they are ready gifts for holiday guests.

BOSTON BREAD

1 1/2 c. graham flour
1 1/2 c. corn meal
1 t. soda
1 t. nutmeg
1 t. salt
2 c. milk
1 c. buttermilk or sour milk
1/2 c. molasses
1 c. seedless raisins
Stir together flour, corn meal, soda, nutmeg, and salt. Combine milk, buttermilk or sour milk, and molasses. Pour all at once over dry ingredients. Mix quickly, just enough to blend, stir in raisins. Fill three well-buttered, one-pound coffee cans about two-thirds full. Cover with foil to securely seal and steam for three hours. Cool completely on cake rack before unmolding. It is good plain or toasted.

CELERY VINEGAR

Add two-thirds cup minced fresh celery leaves and one small grated onion to one pint cider vinegar. Let stand for two or three weeks, then strain through a fine sieve. For gift giving pour into fancy wine or liqueur bottle.

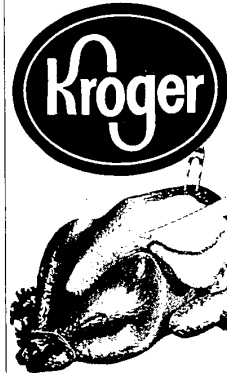
ROQUEFORT MAYONNAISE

1 pint mayonnaise
8 T. chili sauce
2 T. crumbled Roquefort or blue cheese
1/4 t. tarragon
Blend all ingredients well. Pour into apothecary jars, label and tie neck with ribbon.

PORT WINE PUDDING SAUCE

1/2 c. butter
1 c. brown sugar
2 eggs, well beaten
1/2 c. port wine
1 box frozen strawberries, thawed
juice of one lemon
Melt the butter and add the sugar, eggs and wine. Beat with a rotary beater until foamy and slightly thickened. Remove from heat. Drain the juice from the strawberries and pass the fruit through a sieve to make a puree--or whirl in a blender for a few seconds. Add to the hot sauce with the lemon juice and cool. Place in a covered jar and serve cold, or reheat over very low heat--the sauce must not boil. Note: This keeps well refrigerated in a covered glass jar, and freezes equally well.

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
