Meet The Joneses; Hear Renaissance Music

If you are a fan of 16th century music, there's a treat coming when the Schoolcraft College Humanities Series presents Anne and Robert Jones at 8 p.m., Tuesday, Nov. 18.

The couple will play music from the 16th, 17th and 18th centuries in the Liberal Arts Theatre on the Schoolcraft campus.

A concert, with the same musical fare, is scheduled at 4:30 p.m. Sunday, Nov. 16, in the Rosedale Gardens Presbyterian Church. The church is located at the corner of West Chicago and Hubbard in Livonia.

Both concerts are open to the public, free of charge. The church concert is the first of a series of chamber music programs sponsored by Rosedale Gardens.

The viola da gamba is often considered an ancestor to the violin family and is played with the instrument balanced on the musician's knees. Viola da gamba translates into knee viol.

The harpsichord is often thought as the ancestor to the piano, but Jones disagrees with this. He says that the only thing the piano and harpsichord have in common is that "both have black and white keys."

Jones says that the harpsichord is actually an ancestor to the organ.

THE INSTRUMENTS fell from popularity when musical programs were moved from the chambers of the nobility to the concert hall. The tones are not suited to large halls, and the audience couldn't hear the music.

This happened in the middle of the 18th century.

Anne, who received formal training at the college at the University of the Redlands in California, first played the viola da gamba as part of her senior project.


Her husband says that he plays the harpsichord because he originally trained on the organ. Of course, the fact that his wife plays the viola might have something to do with his choice of the instrument.

Music by German (Johann Sebastian Bach, Karl Frederick Abel and Johann Schenck), French (Marin Marais), English (Christopher Simpson) and Spanish (Ortiz) will be included in the program.
