

Hilberry offers classic Irish play

Three classic Laurel and Hardy films, with live theater pipe organ accompaniment, will be the featured attraction at a show presented by the Motor City Theater Organ Society at 8 p.m. Saturday, Nov. 10 at the Redford Theater in Detroit. Organist for the program will be Dennis James, staff organist at the Ohio Theater, a restored movie palace in Columbus.

Films at this Laurel and Hardy festival will be "Habeas Corpus," "Big Business," "The Second Hundred Years."

"Philadelphia, Here I Come!" by Brian Friel officially joins the Hilberry Theater repertory season Wednesday, Nov. 14, at 8:30 p.m., following its introduction at the President's Preview for Sponsors on Friday, Nov. 9.

"Philadelphia, Here I Come!" was Friel's first major play. It was produced in Dublin before coming to New York in 1965, where it became the longest-running Irish play ever to appear on Broadway.

It is the story of a young man, Gareth (Gar) O'Donnell, as he prepares to leave Ireland for a new life and work in Philadelphia, USA. Gar is played by two actors, one as the "public" Gar and one as his alter ego, who keeps popping irreverent thoughts into Gar's head.

Heading the cast are Mark Tymchysyn as Gar (Public) Andrew Barnicle as his alter ego, Gar (Private), and William G. Etter as S. B. O'Donnell, Gar's rather uncommunicative father.

OTHER PRINCIPAL roles are played by Elizabeth Gulek-Eastman as Madge, the housekeeper who keeps the peace between father and son; Beth Taylor as Kate, Gar's lost love who has married another man; and Barbara Acker as Lizzy, Gar's rather tipsy aunt.

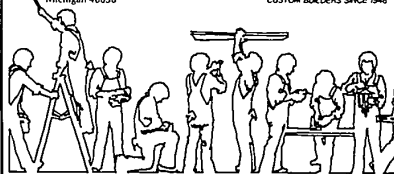

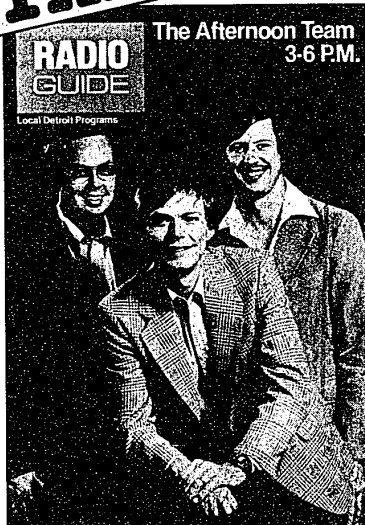

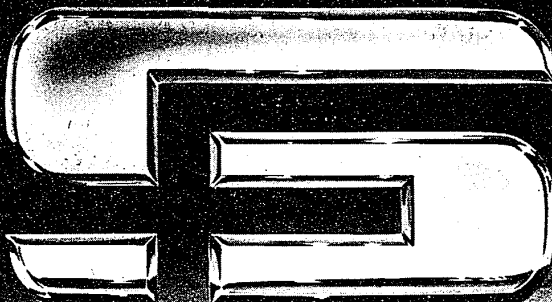
