The couple plan a mid-May ceremony at St. Regis Church in Birmingham.

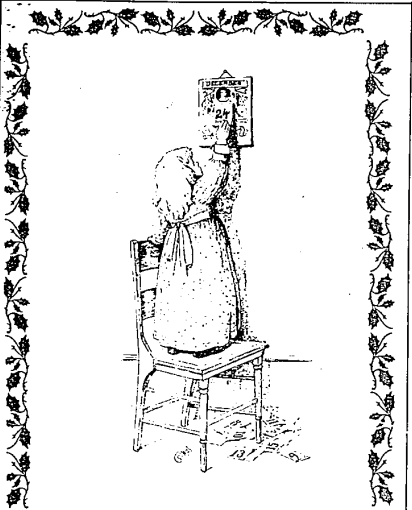
Esch-Bierwirth

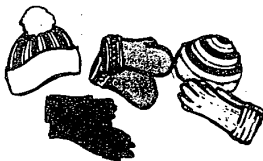

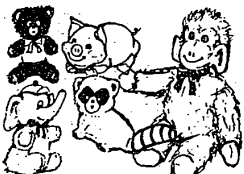
