

Area produces some fine prep golfers

Last year, Manning won the state individual honors. He was 11th in the state tourney this year.

MANNING WAS second in the regional meet with a 77. Finishing first was teammate Graves with a 76. Graves, who averaged 38.9 strokes

during match play, finished one stroke behind Manning in the state tourney with a 77. "He's a super leader for his golf

team," Pasberg said about Graves. "His iron shots, when he's hitting well, go right to the green."

Both Manning and Graves are hoping for scholarship opportunities at a southern college.

Trivison, also a senior, earned medalist honors in four of West Bloomfield's 10 matches. He averaged 38.8 strokes while playing his home meets at Orchard Lake and Tam O'Shanter country clubs, both tougher courses than most high school teams play.

He finished third in the regional with a 74, was second in the GOAL (behind Gieselman) tourney with a 79, and shot a 116 in a 27-hole tournament, the Novi Invitational.

Trivison's best performance, however, was in the Brae Burn Best Ball tournament. He fired a 69 to finish first.

"He certainly has the credentials to go on and play in college," West Bloomfield coach Art Link said.

"His strength and the way he hits the

ball (are his assets). He has one of the best swings I've ever seen." In the voting for the all-area golf coach, six different coaches received one vote each, so no coach could be singled out. But a few should be given some acclaim for accomplishments during the season.

Gerry Chapple of Walled Lake Central and Jerry Hansen of Country Day

each guided their teams to state championships. Don Dennis of Andover pushed his squad to a third-place finish in the state meet, even though the team placed second in the GOAL.

It was Link's team at West Bloomfield that claimed the GOAL championship. Pasberg also coached his Adams squad to a Metro Suburban Association league title.

Oakland Community College's basketball team provided a successful opening last Wednesday for the school's \$2.8-million multi-functional sports arena on the Orchard Ridge Campus in Farmington Hills.
