

Harrison High musicians score again

Harrison High School instrumental students again turned in top scores in state competition sponsored by the Michigan School Band and Orchestra Association in the State Solo and Ensemble Festival.

The right to compete in the festival, held late in March in Roseville, was earned in the district competition the students tied in in February.

A clarinet quartet and six students

earned individual Number One ratings, the highest rating given.

Top achiever in the group was Paula Ross, an 11th grade flute player.

The young flutist chose to be graded in the Proficiency Number 2 category. This is more difficult than Proficiency 1, which is usually reserved for 10th graders and first-time participants; but less difficult than Proficiency 3, reserved exclusively for seniors who

want to accept the highest standards the festival has to offer.

Performers are judged on a solo performance for 50 points; memorization of scales, 25 points; and sight reading, 25 points. A total of 85 points or more is required for a Number One rating.

OTHER HARRISON students who received the Number One rating are Julie Pickett, an 11th grade flutist; Ali-

son Fish, an 11th grade violinist; Lisa Marrich, a 10th grade flutist; and David Londal, a 10th grade trombonist.

The clarinet quartet earning a Number One rating was made up of 11th graders Jaisy Mead and Janet Kastura; and seniors Julie Phillips and Eric Tenenbaum.

All of the highly rated young musicians will be taking part in the school's Spring Music Festival when the school's band, orchestra and choir will be in concert at 8 p.m. Thursday and Friday, May 3 and 4, in the school's auditorium.
