

The Pioneers tallied 170 points, and Cal State-Chico was third with 145. California State-Northridge won the team title with 384 points.

Oakland was led by four record-breaking performances.

Two relay teams, the 400-yard medley and 800-yard freestyle relay, set new school records, while two Pioneer tankers finished first in individual events to become national champions.

Junior Ian Dittus from Birmingham won the 200-yard butterfly, and later set a school record in the 400-yard individual medley. Mark Doyle was the team's other national champion, as he captured the 100-yard backstroke with a time of 52.45.

"We haven't been outside once yet this year," Swidzinski said. "It's hard to tell exactly where our new players will fit in."

"Our biggest concern right now is the weather. Our field had to be dry for 10 days before we can play on it, and there isn't another field in the area suitable for playing," she said.

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
