Rings from drinking glasses are probably the commonest wood finish nuisance. The cure depends on the type of finish in some extent. If you know it's shellac, you can often cure the rings by dipping a little piece of lintless cloth in a finger of clear shellac dissolved in one with denatured alcohol and wiping it lightly around the ring. Don't overdo it. If it doesn't work quickly, quit and let everything dry. Another method that works on many finishes is the pumice-and-oil rubdown. Wipe the area clean of very short intervals so you work and stop rubbing as soon as the job's done. Otherwise you may rub through the finish.
