

# Attic Theater plans Performing Arts Festival

The second annual Attic Theater Performing Arts Festival will sponsor 54 performances by metropolitan area arts groups this summer. The performances will begin Wednesday, June 13 and will continue through Sunday, July 1.

Twelve Michigan companies, most of whom will present original material, will be featured in Wednesday-Sunday performances.

"The Attic's first festival featured eight groups from the area," said Samuel Pollak, festival coordinator. "Because of the wealth of talented performers in Detroit, we've added four groups this year. We've also added Wednesday performances and special kids' shows on the weekend."

The festival schedule includes an after-work show at 6 p.m., an evening show at 8:30, both shows Wednesday-

Sunday; a midnight show each Friday-Sunday, and special kids' shows on Saturday and Sunday at 1 and 3 p.m.

Appearing in the Attic Festival are, For children: June 16, 23, 30 - Magic and All That Jazz (1 p.m.) and Rainbow Celebration with a musical Noah and the ark in "Don't Give Up the Ship" (3 p.m.), June 17, 24, and July 1 - music, mime and dance by Other Things & Co. (1 p.m.) and the mime group Detroupe

(3 p.m.).

Performances for adults will include: June 13, 20, 27 - original works of music, dance and theater from the Theater Company of Ann Arbor (6 p.m.) and Phil Marcus Esser and Jeff Nahan with "Krapp's Last Tape" and "An Original Mime Show" (8:30 p.m.); June 14, 21, 28 - The Theater's production of "Medal of Honor Rag" (6 p.m.) and "Josh" the premiere of an

original drama by the Attic's Don Cook (8:30 p.m.); June 15, 22, 29 - A return engagement of Mirage, an autobiographical dance company (6 p.m.), "Josh" (8:30 p.m.) and David Parker's original stage adaptation of Hemingway's "A Way You'll Never Be" (midnight).

Other performances include: June 16, 23, 30 - Detroupe (6 p.m.) and interview with Ernest Hemingway in

Robert Beaupre's "Hem: An Interview" (8:30 p.m., June 23, 30) and "A Way You'll Never Be" (midnight); June 17, 24 and July 1: "Saltwater Reflections," the 1979 Furry Festival winner (6 p.m.), "Hem: An Interview" (8:30 p.m., June 17, 24), "Josh" (8:30 p.m., July 1).

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## Classic films shown

A mix of new and old film classics has been announced for the "Movies at the Redford" series, presented by the Motor City Theater Organ Society, Inc.

The bi-weekly series at the Redford Theater, 17360 Lahser at Grand River in northwest Detroit, has become a regular entertainment event for many families. The last group of films was regularly attended by 1,000 patrons for each performance, and several programs saw sellout crowds of 1,500.

Films for the latest edition of the series will start at 8 p.m., and are:

- "The Wizard of Oz," June 1 and 2;
- "Naughty Marietta," June 15 and 16;
- "National Velvet," June 29 and 30;
- "Auntie Mame," July 13 and 14;
- "Goodbye, Mr. Chips," July 27 and 28;
- "Topkapi," Aug. 10 and 11;
- "Thoroughly Modern Millie," Aug. 24 and 25;
- and "Merry on the Bounty," Sept. 7 and 8.

As a special feature at each performance, organ overtures and intermissions will be played by an area organist on the Redford Theater's vintage 1928 Barton Theater Pipe Organ. Organ overtures begin at 7:30 p.m.

Some films in the series, including "Goodbye, Mr. Chips," will be presented in 70mm and six-channel stereo — methods known for picture clarity and realistic sound. Few theaters are able to show these prints, however, as most movie houses lack the necessary equipment.

## Favorite screened

"The Thief of Baghdad," a 1940 release directed by Michael Powell ("The Red Shoes"), will be shown by Detroit Film Theater on Friday, May 18, at 7 and 9:30 p.m. in the Detroit Institute of Arts auditorium.

Tickets may be purchased in advance through the museum ticket office (832-2730), or at the door.

Still a favorite film of noted director Francis Coppola and Martin Scorsese, "Thief of Baghdad" is generally considered by film critics as together with "Arabian Nights" to be the best of the genre for its display of color, visual imagination and spectacular special effects. Conrad Veidt and Helen Hayes in this best known Arab tale, which will be shown in a new Technicolor print.

ON SATURDAY, May 19, Detroit Film Theater will feature the Marx Brothers in their comic classic "A Night at the Opera," with all their convoluted, delicious on-the-edge and out-of-control antics. The famed opera was remade three times in the past century, but only this one, with the Marxes, is still available in Technicolor.

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
