Dem Conventions To Begin Friday

Democrats will meet in special county and district conventions to prepare for a state convention on political reform. Here is the schedule:

- Wayne County portion of the 2nd Congressional District will convene Friday, Dec. 5, at 8 p.m. in the Plymouth Community Federal Credit Building, 400 S. Harvey in Plymouth.
- A total 19th District convention will be held Friday, Dec. 12, 7:30 p.m. in Eagle School, 14 Mile and Middle Belt in West Bloomfield.
- The 15th District Democrats will meet once in total district convention Sunday, Dec. 14, 1:30 p.m. at 9500 South Telegraph, Taylor, Garden City and Westland are in the 15th District.
- Oakland County 18th District and 19th District Democrats convene jointly Saturday, Dec. 6 at 10 a.m. at Fontaine Northern High School, to be followed up by separate Oakland 18th and Oakland 19th conventions, Oakland 19th District includes Farmington.

ELECTION OF delegates to Jan. 17 and 18 special State convention is the main order of business.

The state convention will be held in Detroit at the Masonic Temple.

'M' Seeks 4-Year Status In Dearborn

The Dearborn campus of the University of Michigan is going to become a four-year institution.

As part of the celebration marking the 10th anniversary of the school, the U-M regents approved the transition from a two-year school.

While no timetable has been set for the move it was agreed that it should be as quickly as possible.

The regents' actions came as a result of recommendations concerning the Dearborn Campus and Flint College which had been prepared by U-M President Robben Fleming. The recommendations were based on the reports of planning committees composed of faculty members, students, community leaders, and U-M administrators.

In agreeing to the new status for Dearborn the regents said the Dearborn Campus should be developed under the aegis of The University of Michigan for at least five to seven more years.

Under the new plan the regents stated that the educational programs should be developed, to emphasize innovative programs particularly re-

lated to area and community problems.

They further suggested that traditional departmental boundaries might be ignored to achieve such problem-oriented education.

Changing administrative relationships between the Ann Arbor headquarters and the Dearborn and Flint branches are reflected in the appointment of Dean, Stephen H. Sours to a newly created vice-presidency.

And, under his guidance, the present system will be changed to install a chancellor and give both Dearborn and Flint a higher prestige rating.

In reporting the recommendations to the regents, President Fleming called attention to three views common to both the Flint and Dearborn planning committees:

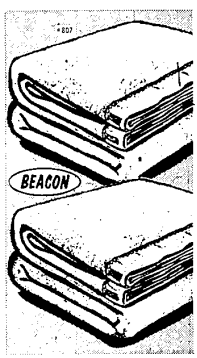
1 -- Both campuses must continue to grow, both in student numbers and academic program.

2 -- Administrative structure at each campus must be strengthened with the start of a chancellor or provost system and with gradual control of its own graduate program.

3 -- Neither campus should be the mirror image of the Ann Arbor campus. "It was an-

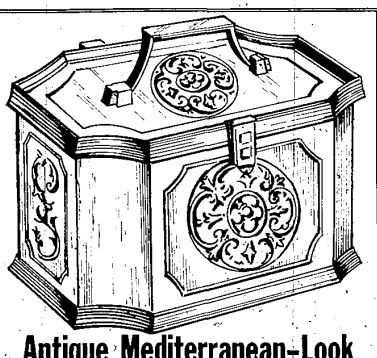

The quarterly dividend is payable after the close of business Dec. 31, to shareholders of record Dec. 1.

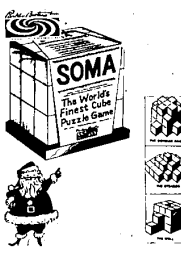
The increase in the dividend was announced jointly by Chairman Raymond T. Boyd and President C. Percy Stockmeyer.
