College ponders how to pay the bills

Schoolcraft College's community services programs have always covered 'current' costs — accounting jar-gon for the salaries and supplies need-ed to run them. or correctational vehicles (17).

College officials currently are strug-gling with the question of whether com-munity services programs should bring in money for "overhead" costs — heat, light, custodial services and administrative costs.

trative costs.
Reluctantly, trustees last week instructed the administration to begin work on a method of recovering some overhead costs.
"It's one of the possible areas in case we do have a negative vote on the June 11 millage," said trustee Gerald Cox.

SCHOOLCRAFT has served more than 21,000 persons this school year with community services, said Presi-dent C. Nelson Grote. One group of services was workshops

to recreational vehicles [17]. Another group is seminars and forums like small business management (72), widowhood [91]. basic law enforcement for police reserves [99], and displaced homemakers [42]. Cultural and public affairs included five chamber music concerts, two lectures, two poetry readings, one theater program and one dance offering, drawing a total of 1,000 persons.

Dinners, dances, films, other certs and physical education drew a total attendance of nearly 17,000.

RON GRIFFITH, dean of communi-ty services, said that while the pro-gram as a whole breaks even, some make money and some are "almost free."

He added, "If you slap on an over-head costs that's as much as the direct cost, you'd price yourself out of the market." He cited the nutrition pro-gram for senior citizens as one to which overhead costs shouldn't be attached. The entire community services budg-et is \$240,000. Fees range from free to \$100.

State Seawood. Press range nous need a \$100. Grote, in a memo to the board, said: "In consideration of the current level of sophistication of our cost accounting system, a plan that is student contact hour-based appears most practical. Specifically, some indirect cost factors could be determined and applied against the annual student contact hours generated by community service students. "The dollar amount could then be computed and transferred annually

from the community services restricted account to the general operating fund."

AT ONE TIME, community colleges could award "institutional credit" for community services course work and receive some state financial assistance.

But in 1976 the Michigan Legislature became upset with paying state money for belly dancing-type courses at one college and disallowed funds for "avocational" courses.

Schoolcraft offers two types of community service courses. "Continuing education" are most nearly traditional, offering credit and generating state funds. The avocational classes — short seminars, workshops and conferences — are credit free and get no state funds, Grote said.
