Historic military music featured at Fort Wayne

concerts

A night of 18th and 19th century military music at Historic Fort Wayne on Tuesday, July 3, will herald the coming of Independence Day in Detroit.

The two-hour concert, sponsored by the International Freedom Festival, will start at 6:30 p.m., on the fort's parade ground, 6553 W. Jefferson at the foot of Livernois. A shot from a Civil War cannon of the Loomis Battery will mark the start of the program.

Featured will be the First Michigan Colonial Fife and Drum Corps; the C. W. Dickerson Music Corps from New York playing music from America's 18th and early 19th centuries; the Fifth Michigan Regimental band presenting music from the Civil War and late 19th century; the Windsor Police Pipe Band; and the First Marine Band from Howell, Mich.

All groups appear in authentic period military costumes and their

maneuvers, armaments, musical arrangements and instruments are those of the periods they represent.

AS AN EVENT of the Freedom Festival, there will be no admission charge for the evening. The gates of the fort will open at 6 p.m., allowing visitors some time to wander through its tunnels, cisterns, powder magazine and ramparts. The Barracks Museum also will be open for inspection.

According to Dr. William Phenix, the fort's curator, "This will be an excellent opportunity for people to hear the music associated with stirring events in America's military history while enjoying a truly unique setting."
