Blood, Sweat, Tears; Herbie Mann scheduled

Blood, Sweat and Tears, the group that first popularized the merging of brass horns to rock and roll beat, entertain Monday, July 30, at Chuck Mue's P'Jazz at the Hotel Pontchar-train terrace.

Herbie Mann, pop jazz flutist, will appear Wednesday, Aug. 1.

Raspy-voiced blues screamer David Clayton-Thomas is the only original member in the new line-up of Blood, Sweat and Tears. The new personnel produce a somewhat different, heavier rhythm and blues, funky-style sound. The group also embraces reggae, flamenco, new generation soul and electronic sounds in the act.

Blood, Sweat and Tears has sold more than 35,000,000 copies of its albums since forming in 1968. Three singles, "And When I Die," "Spinning

Wheel" and "God Bless the Child," were certified gold records.

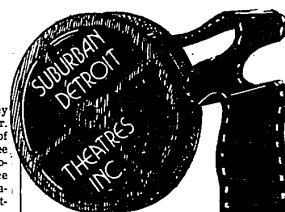
THE CONCERT will begin at 6 p.m. Tickets are available for general admission seats only.

Over the years, with his command of the flute, Herbie Mann and the New Family of Mann have performed Afro-Cuban, Brazilian, Middle Eastern and Memphis styles — forever seeking new musical avenues on which to travel.

Recently Herbie has been exploring the funky and soulful "black Brazilian sound." This features a non-keyboard combo, giving his group "all kinds of space" for the bass and guitar players to work in, without the "10 notes keyboard people still play every time they touch the piano," according to Mann.
