



New Trails For Snowmobile Fans

Snow conditions permitting the Michigan State Department of Natural Resources this weekend will open three experimental areas to cross-country snowmobiling at Dodge 4 State Park and Waterloo Recreation Area on the Washtenaw-Jackson County line north of 194, and 320 acres at Proulx Lake north of Wixom in Oakland County.

The DNR is offering snowmobilers a wide-open test run within the three relatively large tracts of land this winter to see if the areas provide the type of terrain these recreationists prefer for skimming across the countryside. The tracts have been posted open to snowmobiling will also be a proving ground to determine what effect power-skiing has on the landscape.

LAST WINTER, many snowmobilers strayed off trails laid out for them in state parks indicating to the DNR that these winter recreationists favor the type of freedom for cross-country runs which the three experimental areas will provide.

As a measure to protect the landscape, test trails will be open when there is at least four inches of snow on the ground. The areas will be closed to all wheeled vehicles.

Snowmobilers are urged to contact DNR personnel at the three parks before they leave home to find out if snow conditions will permit them to use the new experimental areas. Those bound for the area at Dodge 4 State Park will be required to purchase vehicle entrance permits. Snowmobilers using the special trails set aside for them at Waterloo and Proulx Lake recreation areas in southern Michigan.

Cranbrook Slates Children's Classes

Cranbrook Academy of Art does not concentrate its efforts solely on adult artists. Children, too, may learn the joy of artistic expression at the Academy of Art Galleries' Young People's Art Center (YPAC), whose courses are designed expressly for a child's sensitivity.

THE SECOND term of YPAC courses begins Jan. 3 and ends March 12, 1970. Courses are open to children ages 7 through 19 years for six class sessions, each meeting one and one-half hours weekly for 10 weeks.

"The purpose of YPAC is to instill artistic appreciation in children, not just to make artists of them," says Galleries' director Wallace Mitchell.

YPAC instructor Mrs. Beth Peterson explains: "Children have wonderful imaginations that sometimes need to be drawn out. To encourage and stimulate their creativity, we teach the basic techniques and mix a little work with their play."

Mrs. Peterson, with two assistants, will emphasize sculpture and collage this term. In the loosely structured classes, students will make wire, clay and plaster sculptures. They

Art Institute Displays Morris Sculpture Work

Works of one of the most difficult—and exciting—young sculptors in the United States will go on display at the Detroit Institute of Art Friday, Jan. 9, for four weeks.

The 38-year-old iconoclast is Robert Morris, and five galleries of the South Wing will show the development of his work during the past 10 years.

THE SIMPLIFIED shapes and forms executed in brute materials take the art of sculpture as far from the past as almost any other sculptor at this time, in the opinion of Samuel Wagstaff, curator of contemporary art, who will install the show with the help of the artist himself.

Morris, visiting Detroit from New York for the exhibition, is one of the leaders in minimal sculpture, a recent American breakthrough in form that also embraces Tony Smith, Don Judd, Ron Bladen, Larry Bell, John Chamberlain and Dan Flavin.

Wagstaff emphasized that Robert Morris' influence and activity goes beyond sculpture. Morris is teacher, theoretician, writer and producer of avant-garde dance events.

THIS FIRST major museum Youngsters Find Jazz At Concert

Detroit's Hal McKinney Quartet will present blues, soul, rock 'n' roll and contemporary American jazz in a unique jam session for youngsters at the Detroit Institute of Art Saturday, Jan. 10.

Discovering Jazz, part of the Detroit Youth Theatre's "Something Every Saturday" series, is aimed at entertaining and explaining jazz to boys and girls, six years and older.

The group is Hal McKinney on piano, Sam Sanders, sax; Marcus Belgrave, trumpet; Eddy Pickens, bass and Archie Taylor, drums.

McKinney uses his extensive musical background in a highly original presentation to give boys and girls a solid look at jazz, from ancient to modern times.

He begins his program with a theme from a nursery rhyme, adds and describes the roles of various instruments, and the segment by improvising with various jazz forms. Historical notes about the origin of jazz are added during the hour-long session.

Cultural flashbacks include performances of Egyptian melodies, Baroque modes, African rhythms and Western-European harmonies. All the major jazz forms and techniques are then applied to McKinney's own composition, "Juba."

Performances are at 11 a.m. and 2 p.m. Tickets are at the Art Institute Office and J.L. Hudson ticket centers.

Adult Education Program Announced By Village

A chance to study and learn at one of the nation's best known American history museums is now offered to area residents through an adult education program at Greenfield Village and the Henry Ford Museum in Dearborn.

According to James A. Fowler, director of education, 13 classes begin the week of Jan. 5, to launch the winter term of a continuing program. Tuition is \$1.50 per class hour for the courses which range from 10-1 1/2 to 30 hours depending on content.

Designed to give participants a greater understanding of the collections, crafts and related activities of the village and museum, these new courses will be taught by staff specialists.

Subject matter for the classes ranges from early American clocks, to 19th century theater techniques, to gardening in winter.

SPECIFIC COURSE titles and the instructors are: "Early American Clocks: What Makes Them Tick," Robert Cheyne, Greenfield Village watchmaker; "Gardening in Winter," Marshall Engle, head florist at the village; "Seat Weaving: Came, Rush and Split," Carl Wesenberg, cabinetmaker at Henry Ford Museum; "Rug Hooking," Robert Kaiser, craftsman residing at Greenfield Village; "Advanced Weaving for Adults," Margaret McAlister, village craft teacher; "American Furniture," Robert Bishop, curator of furniture at the museum.

Additional classes are: "Basic Metalworking," Wirt Van Slyke, Greenfield Village silversmith; "Bird Recognition: A Positive Approach to Bird Watching," James A. Fowler, director of education at the museum and lecturer of the National Audubon Society; "Pottery Making for Adults," Donald Kaake, potter at the village; "The Romance of the Automobile," Leslie R. Henry, curator of transportation at the museum.

The Robert Morris Retrospective will be at the Detroit Institute of Arts from Friday, Jan. 9, through Sunday, Feb. 8, during regular museum hours: 9:30 a.m. to 5:30 p.m. on Tuesday, 9:30 a.m. to 5:30 p.m. on Wednesday through Sunday.


