TO COVER UP PEDAL SLOTS

Prevent Drafts in Winter by Tacking Piece of Heavy Material Over Holes in Floor.

close up the pedal slots in floor To close up the pean sola in noot boards to prevent drafts in cold weather, tack a piece of canvas or sheet rubber on the under side of the board over the slot. Cut a silt in the material just large enough for the pedal levers to pass through, making sure that their motion is not impeded.

Free Oil Holes.

Exposed oil holes are bound to fill up with dir; and old grease. It is well to clean out the choked parts and free the holes to assure thorough lubrication to all working parts.

A not infrequent cause of hard start-ing is over-richness of the mixture. Clogging of the cooling system may be preferred by cleaning it at least twice a year with sal soda.

Rubber is very quickly disintegrated by oil, and at the same time it has a most unfortunate capillary affinity for the oil.

That it is extremely danger-ous to allow an automobile en-gine to run in a small garage of other inclosed space, unless the door is open and there is plenty or ventilation. The danger is not to the cer itself, but to those not to the car itself, but to those who are in the garage, for the chaust from the eagine, mixing with the air, forms carbon monoxide and carbon dioxide—the latter being carbonic acig swhich is deadly to all living organisms. In addition, the carbon monoxide is also extremely dangerous and the air from which the crygen has been taken, forms still another meance.




