

Township Ups Police Salary

FARMINGTON Township Police will receive a 5 percent raise after recent final settlement of pay negotiations between the department and the Township Board.

LAST APRIL, the Farmington Police Officers Association (FPOA) agreed on a tentative salary figure of \$2,800 for a patrolman with full seniority.

Neighboring police departments at that time had not settled their negotiations and so the FPOA and trustees did not have any comparison of what a equitable wage package would be.

Tentative agreement was made on the \$2,800 figure pending settlement by neighboring communities of police pay negotiations. The trustees agreed last April that large checks soon after recent final settlement of pay negotiations between the department and the Township Board.

ted, the township would average those pay settlements and make up any difference.

MOST OF THE neighboring communities had not settled by April 1.

All are settled now except Livonia and so an average was taken of the new pay scales negotiated by Hazel Park, Birmingham, Southfield, Bloomfield Township and West Bloomfield Township.

Calculations showed the township fell \$13 short of its promise to make its police salaries comparable with neighboring communities.

Monday night, trustees voted to raise the maximum limit for patrolman by that amount to \$3,013.

Amounting to \$141, trustees also voted to pay the \$13 difference retroactively to April 1, 1969.

Thus, a patrolman with full seniority will be getting a bonus check soon of about \$300.
