"Many answers to solving our children's common behavior problems can be very simple." Dr. Wartel said, who is a Southfield resident and consultant to area schools and community agencies.

He is an advocate of The Patterson Approach to adult-child communication method that is technique oriented, a method that modifies the child's behavior without using corporal punishment.

Dr. Patterson's methods are spelled out in his book, "Families: Applications of Social Learning to Family Life." The class will deal with the reduced of Patterson's ideas and how the work, and will focus on specific necessity of them.

"I believe parents want specific techniques from the professional to modify their child's behavior," Dr. Wartel said. "My sessions will supply immediate methods. We will not go into the underlying causes with these techniques, but if there proves to be a need we will discuss it."

"Children want to know what is expected of them," he said, emphasizing that parents must lay out rules at a calm time and spell out the consequences for not following the rules.

"And most vital, the parent must follow through with the consequences," he said. "The child's I-forgot answer if just not acceptable.

"Kids will test you as you begin a new way of disciplining, but remember, there's always a period of adjustment. The parent has to learn not to give up too easily."

Wartel's class will wind up with a discussion of concerns of the individual class participants.

The class is \$40 for one parent or one couple. Setting the two-for-the-price-of-one fee is Wartel's way of encouraging both parents to take the class at the same time.






