sance mission with the Florida Pinelles Senior Squadron. The squadron runs a community service "Sun Down Patrol" flight along the coast looking for boaters in distress.




As Sixgate Squadron Aerospace Officer her duties include teaching and explaining about flight to squadron cadets to help them advance in the CAP cadet program.
