LEVIN is former Democratic state chairman and also served for a time as Democratic minority leader in the Senate. He has represented the 16th District in south Oakland County since 1955 and has served as chairman of the Senate Labor Committee and vice chairman of the Senate Education Committee.

LOCKWOOD, majority leader in the Senate, recently announced he would not seek re-election from the 30th District and is considered a prospect for the office of Secretary of State.

Lockwood also served three terms as a member of the St. Louis school board and is a former member of the Gratiot County board of supervisors.
