 Make the person in control of an off-road recreational vehicle responsi-ble for preventing its operation by a person under age 12 or a person under the influence of liquor or a controlled substance (HB 5042). substance (HB 5042).

Broadens the power of police officers to arrest, without warrant, persons driving snowmobiles or off-road vehicles on highways and parking lots when it is reasonable to believe the driver is under the influence of alcohol or drugs (HB 5043).
