An April wedding is planned.

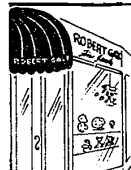

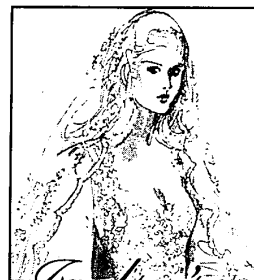

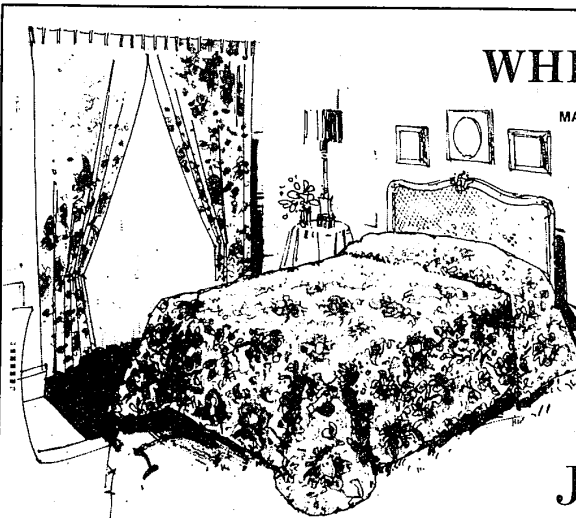
