

Cops seek blonde in murder case

Redford Township police are without a clue to the slayers of two township teen-agers last Thanksgiving Day, but police are seeking a woman who may be able to shed some light on the case.

A blond-haired young woman was seen with one of the victims just hours prior to the time Mariano Maniscalchi, 19, and Sheryl Thornton, 17, were discovered by a passing motorist 1 1/2 months ago at Centralia and Six Mile, within a half-mile of their Redford homes.

Det. Sgt. Gerald Schornack said he would like to question the woman, but efforts to locate her thus far have proved futile. Schornack said the placement of the mystery blonde with Miss Thornton at the 24 Karat Lounge in Detroit the night she was killed has been the only break in the case.

45 minutes before she and Maniscalchi, her date for the evening, were found, according to police.

Under hypnosis, the lounge customer provided a detailed description of the blonde. A police artist has drawn a composite drawing of the mystery woman, Schornack said.

"This woman represents our only lead in the case so far, but no one knows who she is. I'm distributing copies of these drawings to the media and other area police departments in the hope of getting a lead on her whereabouts so we can ask her some questions."

"I'd like to find out who she is to ask her where she and Sheryl (Thornton) went after leaving the bar, when was the last time she saw Sheryl, if Sheryl told her anything and if she saw Mario (Maniscalchi) that night."

"I sure would appreciate a call from anyone who could help us locate her," he said.

Anyone who has seen the woman is requested to notify Redford police at 537-3030.

THE WOMAN is described as white, about 16 or 17 years of age, with shoulder-length blond hair parted in the middle and flaired back on both sides. She is described as pretty, with tear-drop like eyes, a pointy nose, small mouth and baby-faced with a clear complexion.

Schornack said there is a reward being offered for any information leading to the arrest and conviction of the person or persons responsible for the two slayings.

He said the \$7,200 in reward money has been raised by the families of the slain teen-agers and through business donations.

Anyone who may have information about the incident is requested make that information available to Redford police or through the Detroit News Secret Witness Program to collect the reward money, said Schornack.

same six-digit number on a corner of the letter, then tear off that corner and keep it as the informant's receipt.

The letter should be mailed to Secret Witness Program, Box 1333, Detroit 48231.

Miss Thornton, a Redford Union High School student, and Maniscalchi, reportedly out on their first date together, were both beaten to death.

Schornack said he has not been able to confirm that Maniscalchi was at the lounge as no one recalls seeing him there.

Maniscalchi died at the scene, where his body was found lying face down in the middle of Centralia, about 15 feet behind his 1980 Ford Bronco. His death was attributed to massive head injuries, according to an autopsy report by a Wayne County medical examiner.

Miss Thornton, found lying near Maniscalchi, died in Bostford Hospital shortly after being discovered at about 2:15 a.m. She was found about 30 feet from the car on a sidewalk along Six Mile near Centralia.

She died shortly before 7 a.m. from shock and hemorrhaging due to compound skull fractures.

Two previous suspects, including a former boyfriend of Miss Thornton, have been cleared of any involvement after passing polygraph tests, said Schornack.

IN AN EMERGENCY

Keep this number with other emergency listings. Call if you encounter any of the following:

- Leaking natural gas can be heard—a small leak will sound like a hiss; larger leaks are much louder, a shrill noise similar to the "roar" of a jet engine.
- Leaks may blow dust, dirt and rock into the air; cause bubbles, or cause water to be blown into the air if the pipeline is buried under lakes or rivers.
- "Puff" coming from the ground" or burning in the air on a pipeline right-of-way.
- Discoloration of vegetation is another clue.
- A peculiar or unfamiliar odor may indicate a line leak.
