

Slapstick Is Film Fare Sunday

Fun in the air is the comic theme of the Famous Early Movies Series at the Henry Ford Museum Sunday, Feb. 22. The hilarious antics of Laurel and Hardy and Mickey Mouse make it sure-fire entertainment for the whole family.

The slapstick humor of Laurel and Hardy bursts from the screen in "Flying Deuces," a full-length feature film with love, laughs and French Legionnaires.

In this 1939 farce, Stan and Ollie join the Foreign Legion after a misadventure with a Parisian coquette. Their exciting encounters with legion offi-

cials, camels, sandstorms and bands of desert nomads adds up to a frantic, fantastic flurry of fun.

Sharing the spotlight with the two masters of mayhem is a classic cartoon of 1931 vintage, "Mickey Saves the Air- mail." Mickey Mouse fans will love the bravura of his favorite mouse displays in this five minutes of flying fun.

The Famous Early Movies Winter Series runs through March 8 with showings of silent and early sound films Sundays at 2 and 4 p.m. in the

museum theater in Dearborn. There is no additional charge beyond the regular museum admission.

The Michigan State Council for the Arts has announced a far-ranging program to take the fine arts directly to the people in all sections of the country.

Announcement of the program was made during a luncheon sponsored by the Michigan Fine Arts Foundation. The foundation has outlined a campaign to raise \$50,000 by private contribution to support the new program.

NEW CHAIRMAN of the

council is W. Calvin Patterson of Birmingham. Patterson succeeds Durward B. Varner, former Oakland University chancellor and now chancellor of the University of Nebraska.

Varner was the principal speaker at the luncheon and outlined the program he had initiated during his chairmanship of the council.

Varner said the program would take the best in theater, music and the arts to the inner cities, union halls and the smallest and most remote communities in the state. He

proposed the creation of 20 regional art centers, workshops, a mobile theater presenting live performances on streets and in parking lots, concerts in city parks, and artists-in-residence working full time to relate their talents to others.

He said that tens of thousands of tourists visiting Michigan every year would boost new summer festivals proposed to present music, opera and ballet in the western part of the state and the Upper Peninsula.

THE MICHIGAN Council for the Arts was created by the Legislature in 1966. It enables communities to present the best in the arts without fear of financial failure by underwriting part of the cost when necessary.

The council also provides a consultant service and supports special programs to stimulate cultural growth.

The Michigan Fine Arts Foundation is a private organization to enrich Michigan cultural life and implement programs of the council. Mrs.

Edsel B. Ford is honorary chairman of the foundation, while Clyde C. Bennett Jr. of Birmingham is president. Chairman of the foundation's current fund drive is A.H. Aymond of Jackson.
