• Family of four: Free — \$10,270 or less. Reduced — \$10,271 to \$15,490.

• Family of five: Free — \$11,800 or less. Reduced — \$11,801 to \$17,870.
• Family of six: Free — \$13,320 or less. Reduced — \$13,321 to \$20,250.
• Family of seven: Free — \$14,850

or less. Reduced — \$14,851 to \$22,620.
• Family of eight: Free — \$16,370 or less. Reduced — \$16,371 to \$25,000.
• Each additional family member:

Free — \$1,530 or less. Reduced: \$1,531 to \$2,380.
The new guidelines differ from previous guidelines in three ways. They are based on Federal Office of Management and Budget guidelines that aren't adjusted by the Department of Agriculture.
They remove hardship provisions. And third, in place of hardship provisions, they include a standard deduction.
Local school officials are required by law to make changes in the guidelines. These changes will affect the eligibility of some children for free and reduced price meals and free milk.

THE NEW INCOME GUIDELINES are effective Feb. 15.
