Art institute opens new facilities

The heart of the Detroit Institute of Arts will 'open again next Tuesday, marking the end of \$3.6 million of im-provements in public facilities inside the main building.

Cafe service will resume in the new sky-lighted Kresge Court. Other addi-tions include new restrooms, a new North-South corridor connecting the museum's two wings on the ground level, new ticket service facility and auditorium lounge area and a new table service restaurant with cocktails during noon hours.

The interto project, largest ever undertaken by the art institute required 18 months to complete. It was made possible by a \$1,914,000 grant from the Kresge Foundation with additional funds from the Founders Society. The design is by William Kessler and Asso-

ciates, Architects. The R. E. Dailey Company acted as construction mana-ger. Museum director Frederick Cumm-

Museum director Frederick Cummings describes the "Kresge Sequence" as the midway point in the Five Year Capital Improvement Plan (1979-1983) which calls for refurbishing the interior and exterior spaces before the Centennial Year 1985.

Cummings said work on the public park surrounding the art institute continues on schedule. The expected completion date of the Woodward Entry Plaze with stepped waterfall, fountains and driveway is July 1. The entry plaze is made possible by a gift from the Benson and Edith Ford Fund.

Meanwhile, the start of construction

den is funded by Mrs. Allan W. Sheldon. Landscaping of the entire museum per-imeter is planned after 1982. Still to be financed are the restora-tion of the 54-year old auditorium and lecture / recital hall and interior con-struction of a Teacher Resource Cen-

The Five-Year-Plan, Cummings said, will modernize the beautify the 96-year old museum and facilitate its one million annual local attendance.
