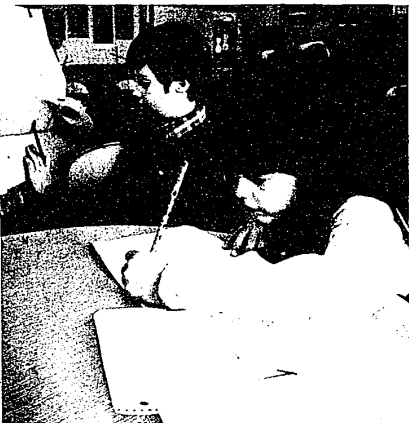




Debbie Hoetger (left), a student at Longacre school, and Susan Weber from Eagle elementary sharpen their musical skills in preparation for the Reflections contest.

Judging will be based on creative ability and expression.

Age categories are primary (grades 1 to 3), intermediate (grades 4 and 5),

junior high (grades 7 to 9) and senior high (grades 10 to 12).

Divisions will be paintings and drawings, poetry, prose or drama, and scores of original composition with or without words.

Each entry must be related to the theme and must be the original work of the students.

Entry deadline is March 16.

Each student who enters will receive a certificate of participation from the State PTA office following the annual state conference.
