"I hope they left with some coping skills," Mrs. Bridges said. "They're tolerating each other better at least."

To help the hospital staff help the sick, Dr. Lagerfeld has a few suggestions for the public.

- Bring in any prescription drugs or illicit drugs the patient is taking. Medication can affect the treatment. Persons can confuse the names of two entirely different drugs (for example Lithium and Lithium) if asked to rely on memory.

- If at all possible have a family member accompany the sick to the hospital. Communication is vitally important, especially when the patient is unconscious, too frail to talk or unable to speak English.

- Parents who leave their children with friends or relatives while out of town are advised to sign a statement authorizing hospital, or any other hospital nearby, to treat that child in the event of an emergency where the parents cannot be reached.

Farmington Hills Police Chief John Nichols, like Patterson, is worried Crosby may disappear before the case comes back in district court. He and the prosecutor also fear that Crosby might attempt to harm or threaten an alleged accomplice in the case, Adrian Fleming, 18, of Detroit. Miss Fleming, the prosecution's chief witness, is out on bail on a larceny charge.

"Sure I was upset," Nichols said Friday morning. "We have a guy on the street with a predilection for violent crime."

Nichols said he doesn't understand why the judge ordered the release when the delay was caused by the defense motion.

"The only damn thing I know is we got a guy out I'd just as soon have in," Nichols said.

Judge Webster's court clerk said the judge had no alternative but order the release on personal bond because the prosecutor never demanded a trial date set before the deadline.

Surveillance will be maintained to make sure Crosby doesn't leave town, Patterson said. Police Chief Nichols said his department couldn't tail Crosby until Tuesday's court date, explaining such a move "would tie up one-sixth of our department."

ATTORNEY LADUE said by complaining to the press, Patterson "has got the guy convicted of murder before he's even been tried."
